


# String Students!!!

You will be going to Essential Elements Interactive and setting up your account. You will need some information, however, so check out below:

1. Go to [www.essentialelementsinteractive.com](http://www.essentialelementsinteractive.com).
2. Click on "Students" and click "Create an Account"
3. Enter "CrotonStrings2020" as the school code
4. Enter your assigned number from the file I shared with you in Google Classroom as your ID. Go to **Classwork** and then **Resources** in the Classroom.
5. Select all three checkboxes (you have your own copy of the book, you agree to the T&C (read it if you wish), and you have an older book without an activation code)
6. Enter the ISBN-13 code for your book: 9780634038198
7. Create your username and password.



You now have access to a great deal of online resources that we can use. If I create assignments for you, they will be in the "assignments" section.

If you hover over the icon, it will tell you what it is. These are the same exercises that we have been playing in class.

You can access any line in the book by clicking on the big microphone in the upper right corner. This is the Music Studio. You can practice any of the music you wish.

The website includes a recording function for you to play the material and submit it to me. You have the option of having an accompaniment track play along, the melody play along, or a metronome. It is suggested to use headphones (only in one ear) to help you keep up with the accompaniment track while you perform.

Once you submit a recording, I can listen to it. I would love to hear how you are all doing.
